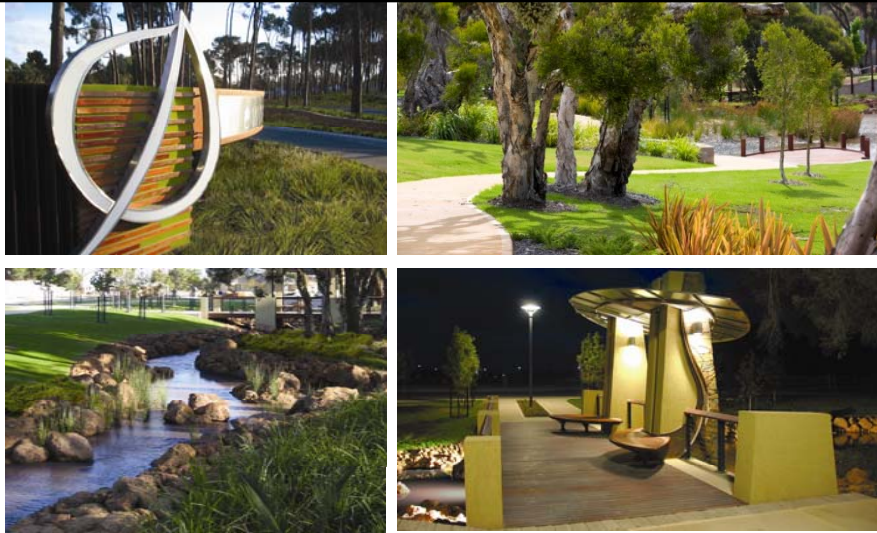


MNLA PROJECTS WIN 2009 WEST AUSTRALIAN UDIA AWARDS



NEWHAVEN for Stockland

The Newhaven project in the southeast corridor of Perth, Western Australia is a Masterplanned community ultimately housing 5,000 people. McNally Newton Landscape Architects have undertaken the provision of Landscape Architectural services for the project since its inception.

In September 2009 Newhaven was recognised by the Western Australian Division of the Urban Institute of Australia (UDIA) for the **2009 UDIA (WA) Best Residential Development over 250 lots**. The project is located in a former floodplain characterised by a high groundwater table and contains a series of drainage and local water management challenges significantly informing the landscape design, function and layout response.



BRIGHTON for Ocean Springs Pty Ltd

The Brighton project is a large master planned community of 15,000 people in the northern coastal fringe of Perth. This project has a series of development villages including the 'Ridgewood' precinct which has been specifically targeted as an affordable housing precinct catering for local needs.

In September 2009 Brighton was recognised by the Western Australian Division of the Urban Institute of Australia (UDIA) for the **2009 UDIA (WA) Best Affordable Development**. Works have included specific landscape treatments, material selections and streetscape design to provide quality visual amenity while maintain affordability in lot pricing. Ridgewood is a mixed higher density precinct serviced by a new rail line and train station as well as major arterial roads.
